3. Information General

Eligibility

IRV membership is required in order to compete at official IRV championships (World Championships, Team World Cup). The nationality of a gymnast is determined by his/her passport.

Qualified Teams

The Team World Cup 2019 is a team competition to which (in general) the four best teams from the last World Championships qualify.

The following teams qualified for the Team World-Cup 2019:

Team 1: Germany	1st place WC 2018
Team 2: Switzerland	2nd place WC 2018
Team 3: Japan	3rd place WC 2018
Team 4: the Netherlands	4th place WC 2018

All teams are entitled to register one delegation leader and one coach. All teams must register 4 gymnasts and 2 or 5 judges.

Attention:

Each official participant (gymnasts, coaches, judges) is personally responsible for having an **international insurance policy** (including health insurance).

4. Information Competition

Accreditation

Accreditation for all delegation members (delegation leaders, athletes, coaches and judges) is mandatory:

Friday 19th April 2019, from **16.00 to 17.00** in the **Comfort Hotel Akita**

or

Saturday 20th April 2019, from **9.00 to 10.00** in the **Akita View Hotel**

Competition Format A

A team consists of 4 gymnasts (juniors and/or seniors) performing the following six disciplines:

- 2 x straight-line to music
- 2 x spiral
- 1 x vault
- **1 elective routine** (either straight-line to music **OR** spiral **OR** vault)

A gymnast may perform **up to three exercises** – but **maximum one exercise per discipline**.

Competition format B:

- Each team enters its gymnasts in the start list without knowing the order in which the other teams have entered their gymnasts.
- **NEW: When all the teams have handed in their line-ups, the starting list will be made public for the teams.**
- The competition will consist of six rounds. One gymnast per team will compete in each round.
- At the end of each round the gymnasts' scores will decide the order within the round (highest to lowest). The teams will be awarded points on the basis of this order:
 - Winner of the round: 4 points
 - Second place in the round: 3 points
 - Third place in the round: 2 points
 - Fourth place in the round: 1 point
- At the end of six rounds the sum of these points will give the final team scores.
- Each team has the opportunity to nominate **ONE JOKER** at the beginning of **one** of the six rounds. This joker means that the points obtained by the team for that round will be doubled. A joker has to be nominated **IMMEDIATELY BEFORE** the teams reveal which gymnasts are competing in the round.
- It is possible for all the teams to nominate their joker in the same round or for the jokers to be nominated in different rounds.

Tickets

Tickets for the Team World-Cup are for free **free** (There are over 2,000 seats in the Akita Prefectural Gymnasium).

Farewell Party: A Farewell Party with all official delegation members (gymnasts, judges, coaches etc.) and fans etc. will be held after the Team World Cup in the **Akita View Hotel**. **All official delegation members have free entrance! All other visitors must buy tickets.** Tickets include unlimited free drinks (beer, wine, sake and non alcoholic drinks) and can be bought at the entrance of the venue in the Akita View Hotel. The price of this tickets is JPY 2,500. Payment is only cash in Japanese yen.

5. Information Judges

The teams Germany, Switzerland and the Netherlands must register two judges. Team Japan must register 5 judges (local organiser) The judges must not be competitors or have any other official function at the Team World-Cup. All judges must have a national or international judging qualification (written confirmation of judging competence) and must have judging experience **in all three disciplines** at a national or an international level. The IRV Judging Officer will decide which judges to use in the Team World-Cup.

All judges are requested to dress according to the following dress code:

- **Black trousers. NOT jeans!**
- **White shirt/blouse**
- **Black blazer/jacket (no leather)**
- **Tie (men)**
- **Suitable black shoes. NO trainers! NO stilettos!**



6. Framework Programme and Activities

Framework Programme

Sightseeing Tour 1 on Saturday (20th April) is for all participants (official delegation members, volunteers and fans) and is for free. The meeting place for the sightseeing is the entrance of the Akita View Hotel at **10 am**. Participants of this sightseeing will do a walk and come back to the hotel at around 11:30 am. On this sightseeing you can see beautiful cherry blossoms and experience the traditional activity in Akita "Kanto".

The **Welcome Party** on Saturday (20th April) is for official delegation members of the four delegations and VIP only. The party will be held at the room in the gymnasium from 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm after official training.

Farewell Party; Please check ticket information.

Sightseeing Tour 2 (Optional; will cost approximately JPY 10,000-15,000)
Akita International University students are planning the special tour from Monday (22nd April) to Tuesday (23rd April). They are planning to bring you to places where you can freely relax, experience the Japanese culture and see and experience beautiful nature.

But there is a limit of 40 participants for this sightseeing. Therefore, if there are too many applicants, official delegation members will be given priority. Please make an application until **11th March**. Payment is on the day of the tour and only in cash (Japanese Yen).

Neglecting this deadline or incomplete payments will mean that the country will lose their right of participation!
